Massachusetts-based Cousin Auntie's Ghost began around 2016 when three women decided to put together a girl band. Over the next few years, many different female musicians filtered in and out of the group, enjoying weekly girls' night full of music, laughter, while learning how to balance busy work lives, parenting, and various other passions with our love for music. As the girls became more comfortable playing music in a group, they started toying with the idea of adding boys to the group. Unsure how this would play out, but knowing many talented male musicians, boys were invited in.... And, lo and behold, the boys added much to the music and didn't kill the girl vibe!

Today Cousin Auntie's Ghost is a base group of 3 women and 4 men, sometimes more and sometimes less, with ages ranging anywhere from pre-teens to seventies depending on who's around. Their music includes classic soul (Otis Reading's Sittin' On the Dock of the Bay and Hard to Handle), rockabilly (Elvis's Sun Sesson song Mystery Train), country (Little Big Town's Beer, Wine and Whiskey, and Chris Stapleton's Tennessee Whiskey), rock classics (War's Spill that Wine, Small Faces, Ooohh La La; Jim Croce's Don't Mess With Jim; Bonnie Raitt's cover of John Prine's Angel from Mongomery), Americana tunes (John Hartford's Long Hot Summer Day), Contemporary Alt (Mt Joy's Silver Lining).

Cousin Auntie's Ghost also plays a host of originals, influenced by a wide range of musical interests. There are several multi-instrumentalists in the group and members' experience includes Classical/Jazz, Folk-Harmony, Metal, Rock, Hip-Hop, Reggae, Funk, Junkanoo and Salsa...
