Snow Crow, a band based out of Groton, Mass, returns to the Susquehanna Summer Solstice Fest for their second year. Dan Fassett, the band leader, is originally from the Meshoppen area, having grown on up a dairy farm just west of town. Dan is also one of the founding members of SSSF and a tireless volunteer and worker for the event.

Snow Crow started as a band of friends brought together through their mutual love of playing music and desire to participate in a thriving local music, arts, and environmental scene in Massachusetts that has emerged over the years. Since then, they have performed in Vermont, Pennsylvania, Canada and beyond, and have a particular love of playing outdoor festivals such as Earth Day celebrations, environmental benefits, and River fests.

Their music is energetic and eclectic—Dan Fassett, calls it "Earth-Sol Folk 'n Roll"—and while the label of "Americana" is a good fit for this band, what distinguishes their collaboration is a range of tastes and tunes that also include folk, pop, blues, reggae, world music and more. And as well as covers, most of the members also write their own songs.

On any given gig, you might hear songs from artists such as Otis Reading, Bruce Cockburn, Rory Block, The Waterboys, Jesse Winchester, Richard Thompson, and Molly Tuttle, as well as several band originals.
